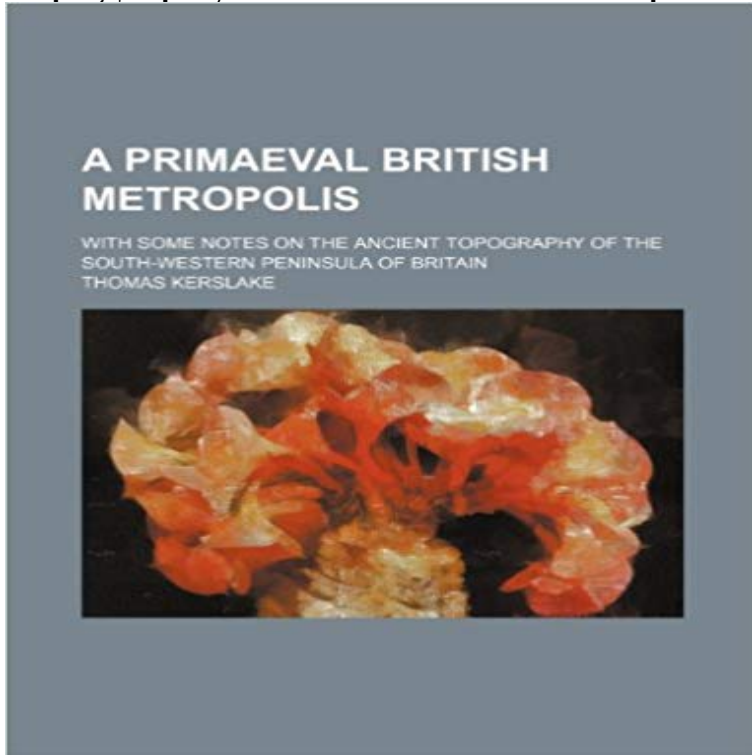


A primaeval British metropolis; with some notes on the ancient topography of the south-western peninsula of Britain

On the other side, the steep north-western escarpment or outcrop looks down upon that one of the extensive Somersetshire levels in which occurs the junction of the Ivel with the Parrett. Beyond the northern ending of this western escarpment, about equal to it in height, but insulated in advance of it, stands out, like a sentinel upon the deep combs and valleys of the range, the hill and castle of Camelot or Cadbury. This block of high country, as already said, was most likely included in Selwoodshire. Sherborne, Milborne-Port, Charlton Horethorne, and several considerable places, nestle in the deep valleys that intersect it; and in these are also the sources of several streams that afterwards become considerable. One of these, the Yeo or Ivel, takes its rise in seven springs, at a place called The Seven Wells, or The Seven Sisters, a secluded spot at the top of the small valley in which, scarcely three miles lower, lies Sherborne: with its Norman castle, apparently occupying the earthworks of a strong fortress that had previously commanded the widened junction with another valley. From this deep and narrow interior valley, close to the Seven Sisters, arises a large, nearly quadrangular platform, sloping upwards until it is terminated westward by the lofty and precipitous escarpment itself, commanding an extensive prospect over the Somersetshire plain, and overlooking Ilchester and the Fosse-way.
