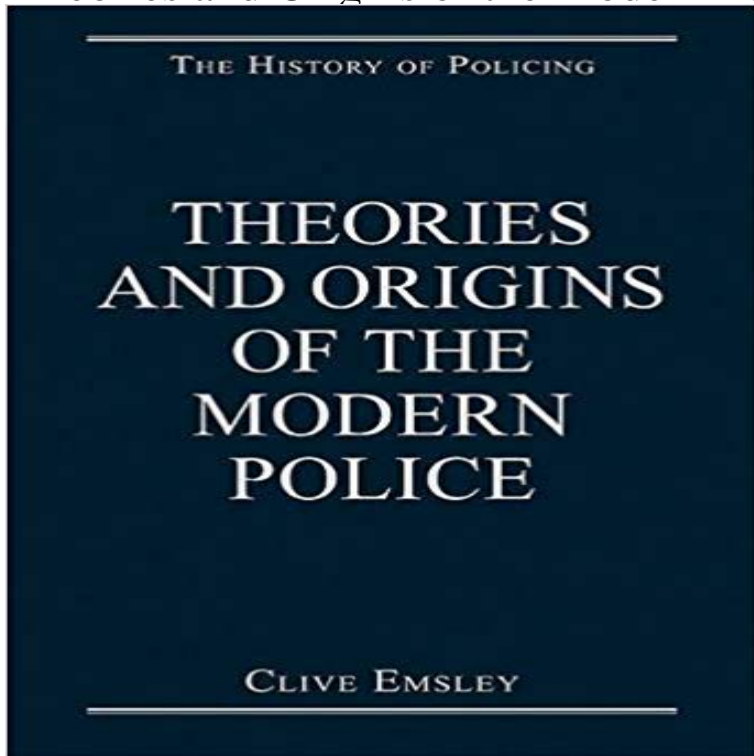


Theories and Origins of the Modern Police (The History of Policing)
